Weather Summary (till 0830IST)

Rainfall occurred at few places over the state during last 24 hours.

No appreciable change in Minimum temperatures & Maximum temperatures decreased by 1 to 2^oC during last 24 hrs.

Minimum temperatures were 2 to 3^oC below normal & Maximum temperatures were 3 to 4^oC below normal.

Today the Lowest temperature was recorded at **Keylong= 8.0^oC** and **Yesterday's** Highest temperature was recorded at **Una & Paonta Sahib = 39.0^oC**.

WEATHER FORECAST for t-9he state of Himachal Pradesh

Yesterdays Western Disturbance as a trough with its axis at 5.8 km amsl now runs roughly along Lang 74^oE to the north of Lat 30^oN.

The cyclonic circulation over Punjab & adjoining areas of Haryana & northwest Rajasthan extending upto 3.1 km amsl persists. The trough at mean sea level from Punjab to Nagaland across south Haryana, south Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Sub Himalayan West Bengal and Assam persists.
